For digital tech occupations, problem solving and troubleshooting also feature in the top 30, as do a number of software programs. For creative occupations, 'creativity' is unsurprisingly a frequently requested skill, as are a number of specialist skills relating to sales and marketing.

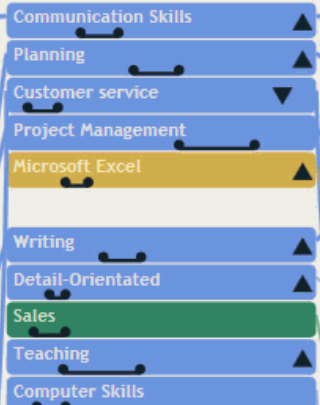

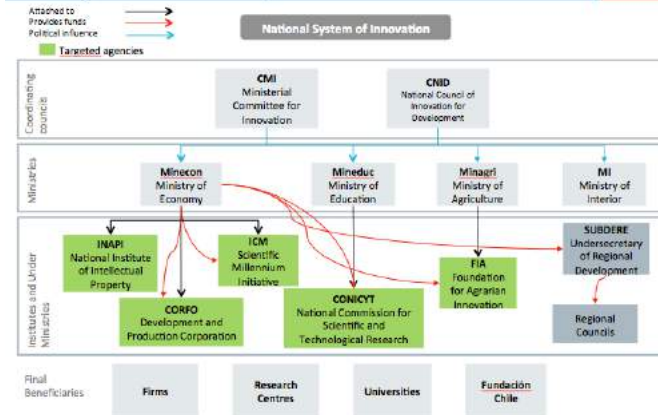

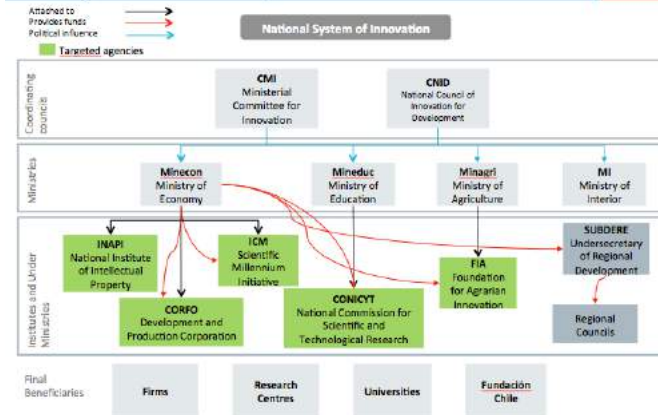
